Additionally, the program continues to gather valuable feedback from graduates and their cooperating teachers through targeted surveys. This feedback is instrumental in evaluating and refining the curriculum to ensure it is still effective in preparing candidates for diverse teaching environments and meets the evolving needs of the educational field.

The new 2016 Teacher Certification Test (PCMAS; PR10, PR21 and PR25) was completely restructured in 2016. It integrates knowledge and Professional Competencies (PR10, PR21 and PR25) in a single total scaled score (40 to 160) that is identified as “PCMAS General” in this report. The open-ended items in the Pedagogical Situation section of the General Test are used to differentiate secondary from elementary level teaching candidates.
